

Community Living-Central Huron Evelyn M. Carroll Scholarship

Financial Support for people with a developmental disability who want to further their post-secondary education, training or apprenticeship.

Deadline for Application is Friday, October 23, 2020.

Value:

Up to \$1,000./annually per scholarship;

A person may be eligible to receive this grant for a maximum of two years, but must submit an application each year.

Who is eligible:

- must be a Member of Community Living-Central Huron; Membership cost \$5.00;
- a person with a diagnosis of a developmental disability who wants to pursue post-secondary education/training/apprenticeship;
- Post-secondary may be full-time or part-time, but must be a minimum of one year and should lead to employment possibilities;
- must be a resident of Community Living-Central Huron's catchment area and be registered (or registering) for the post-secondary program;

How can the funds be used:

Successful applicants may use the funds for any educational related purpose, such as:

- tuition/registration fees;
- textbooks and/or related materials;
- pre-training for program for which the individual has registered;
- other appropriate uses, as determined by the Awards Committee.

How to apply:

Submit a letter, which must include the following:

- indicate "Application for the Evelyn M. Carroll Scholarship," including the applicant's name, address and telephone number;
- what education, training and work experience the applicant has had to date;
- how the funds will be used (for tuition, registration fees, books, other);
- describe what kind of work the applicant hopes to do after the training is completed;
- what the applicant's future plans are (eg. further training, education, volunteer work, employment, personal development, etc.);
- name, address and telephone number of 3 people whom the Awards Committee may talk to about the applicant for a reference. One person should be from the applicant's current educational program; one person should be from the applicant's work/work experience/training program and one from the applicant's support provider/caregiver, who has known the person for a number of years.

How Scholarships will be awarded:

The successful applicant(s) will be chosen by the Awards Committee and be selected on the basis of:

- meeting the eligibility criteria as outlined above;
- the suitability of the post-secondary program to the applicant's career goals and plans;
- the suitability of the funds to the needs of the applicant in the post-secondary program.
