

Community Living-Central Huron Florence and Arthur Maskell Scholarship

Financial Support for an individual who is furthering their post-secondary education, training or apprenticeship in the field of Developmental Services.

Deadline for Application is Friday, May 10, 2019.

Value:

Up to \$1,000./annually per scholarship;

A person may be eligible to receive this grant for a maximum of two years, but must submit an application each year.

Who is eligible:

- must have a 'B' Average;
- an individual who promotes equality of all people;
- must be a resident of Community Living-Central Huron's catchment area and must be registered (or registering) for a Developmental Service Worker post-secondary program;
- preference to individuals who are a Member of Community Living-Central Huron;

How can the funds be used:

Successful applicants may use the funds for any educational related purpose, such as:

- tuition/registration fees;
- textbooks and/or related materials;
- related transportation costs.

How to apply:

Submit a letter, which must include the following:

- indicate "Application for the Florence and Arthur Maskell Scholarship," including the applicant's name, address and telephone number;
- up-to-date resume stating education, training and work/volunteer experience;
- how the funds will be used (for tuition, registration fees, books, other);
- describe your career plans following post-secondary education;
- a 500 word essay responding to one question:

How Do I support inclusion for all?

- name, address and telephone number of 3 people whom the Awards Committee may call for a reference. One person from the applicant's current educational program; one person from the applicant's work/work experience/training program and one personal/family reference.

How Scholarships will be awarded:

The successful applicant(s) will be chosen by the Awards Committee and be selected on the basis of:

- meeting the eligibility criteria as outlined above;
- interview (phone or in-person) with one or more members of the Awards Committee;
- the suitability of the post-secondary program to the applicant's career goals and plans;
- the suitability of the funds, to the needs of the applicant in the post-secondary program.
