Any person who wants to access services for adults with developmental disabilities must go through Developmental Services Ontario (DSO).

You can call DSO at anytime prior to the application process for information and to ensure you have all necessary documents.

The DSO is then contacted 6 months before the child turns 18 to start the application process.
