We are pleased to offer several opportunities for you and your child or youth to join together with peers in a new environment to develop and practice new skills.

- ✓ Groups are for both parents/caregivers and their children/youth with ASD to enjoy together therefore participation by parents/caregivers (18 years or over) is required
- ✓ Groups will typically be 8 10 sessions, one hour in length with the first session for parents/caregivers only.
- ✓ Parents/caregivers will receive support and guidance from an ABA-based services staff
