The Support Worker will initiate appropriate procedures should an emergency situation arise. The Support Worker will also assist individuals in carrying out their routines and implementing protocols/Individual Plans.

**Core Responsibilities of the Position:**

1. Support individuals in their morning/daily routines, as required/directed in the Agency’s Guiding Principles and other Agency philosophical statements.
2. Assist with gathering information and offering suggestions/ideas to individuals receiving support regarding inclusive options and Person Directed Plan Goals.
3. Maintain effective, open communication and cooperation with individuals receiving support, coworkers and Supervisor.
4. Provide support flexibility as required/directed.
5. Provide quality care consistent with all Agency Policies and Procedures, including the Occupational Health & Safety Act (Section 28) and Medication Policy and Procedures Manual.
6. Report for duty in emergency situations, if available.

**Requirements:**

- **Part Time Nights (Asleep)** (\$21.65/hour) - OSSD/Equivalent and a minimum of 1 years’ experience or education in Developmental and/or Human Services and minimum 6 months’ experience.
- 6-months current, clear Vulnerable Sector Check, Valid Class “G” Ontario Driver’s License, 3-year driver’s abstract, Proof of two million dollars third party liability insurance *\*Agency vehicle will be available for use while supporting individuals*
- Availability to work a variety of shifts
